

## **Provincial Government Appeals Class Action Certification Granted to the SRA**

The CBC reported on its website <http://www.cbc.ca/sask/story/class-action060412.html> that the provincial government intends to fight a court decision that certified a multi-million-dollar pension dispute as a class-action lawsuit.

The matter will be heard before an appeal court judge on May 24.

The article states that “If the province is successful, the lawsuits would be dealt with on an individual basis.”

In the article, Gord Kuski stated he wasn't surprised to get the government's notice it wants to appeal, but it's bad news for his clients because it will delay the case. Some could pass away before it's concluded, he said. Mr. Kuski goes on to say, “The people that we represent, a lot of them, are elderly and in their declining years,” he said.
