

Proposed SRA Bylaw Addition:

Feedback at the SRA Town Hall held on September 24, 2020 suggested that members need a process where they can raise issues and ask questions. The SRA Board of Directors reviewed the request and decided that the current bylaws do not provide a process for members to provide feedback and direction to the Board. The Board is bringing forth the following bylaw amendment to respond to this concern.

New wording under Article 14 MEETINGS, 14.2.5.d be added as follows:

“Members wishing to present a motion at the AGM must submit such motion to the SRA office listing the name of the mover, seconder and the intent of the motion, a minimum of 40 days prior to the AGM to allow ten days for the preparation and inclusion of the said motion with the written notice of the AGM which is sent out to all members and the auditor thirty days prior to the AGM.”
